As a photographer, local artist Arto Djerdjerian is an observer of urban life as it passes by him in its every nuance. His photographs are multi-layered and capture what he finds fascinating: a form, a shape, a gesture, a colour, as well as an interaction between people or an interplay of light and shadow. Djerdjerian invites the viewer to explore and discover the beauty in the subtleties of daily urban life and find the little treasures in his works that raise more questions than answers.

These photos have not been *modified*, nothing has been added or removed. They are as shot; basic adjustments have been made, and some have been cropped to finish the image. All work was printed by Djerdjerian, using archival pigment inks.
