### Did You Know?

The *Where's My Tribe?* logo was designed by our board member, Carol Lynn Gilchrist and depicts a person full of movement with outstretched arms who appears to float over three circles. These symbolize the literary, performing and visual art sectors and the primary colours represent all the colour possibilities – as each of us is unique. The white circle represents the cultural sector because when we make or experience art it resides in our memory. The outer shape with the arms breaking through signifies that although we may pursue our art in isolation we come together and link arms.
