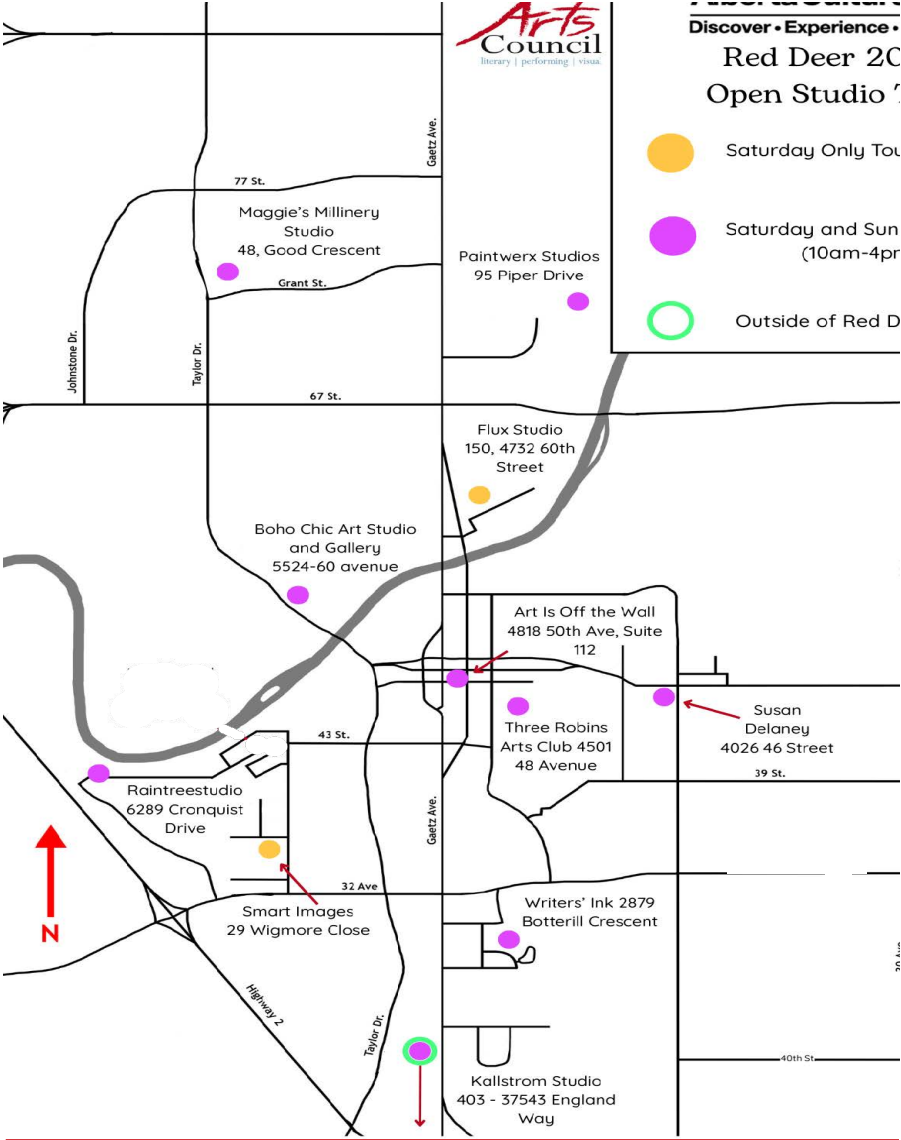

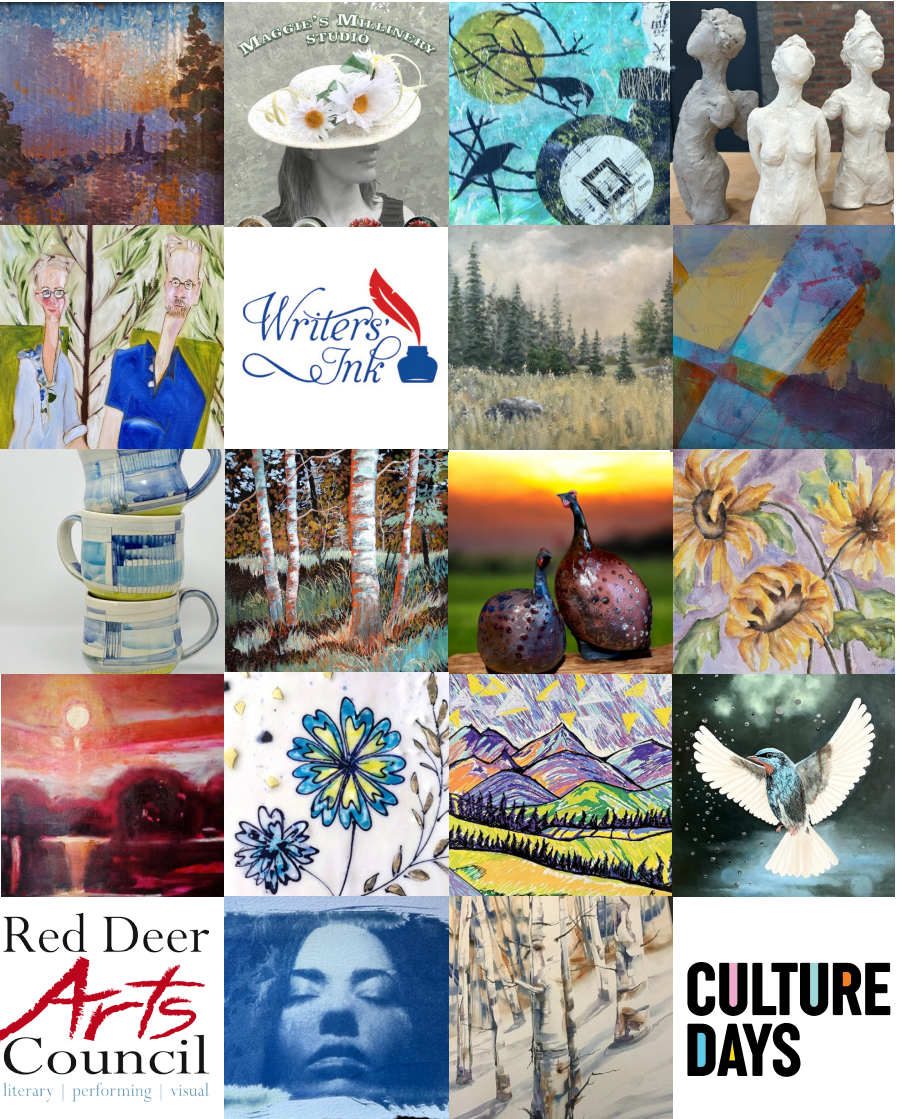

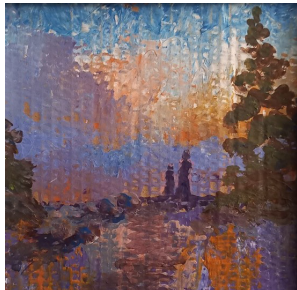

Demonstrating techniques to encourage visitor participation in a collaborative abstract painting.

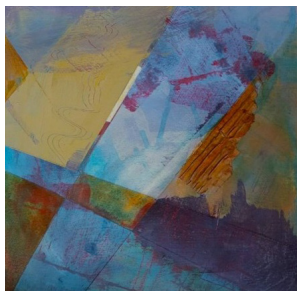

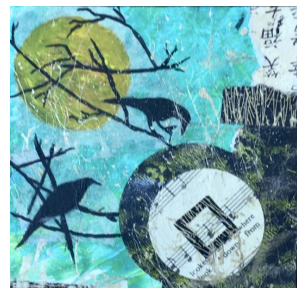

Demonstrating subtractive painting where the object or thing being painted emerges from wiping paint off of the canvas instead of putting it on.

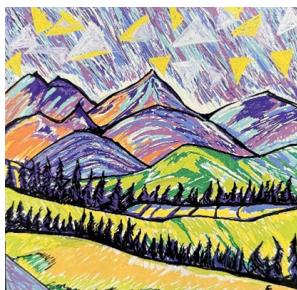

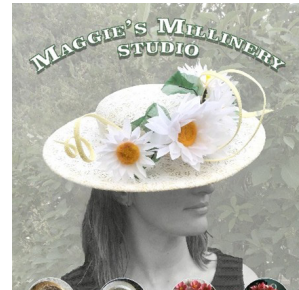

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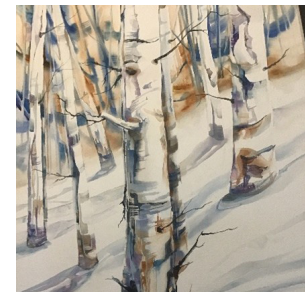
