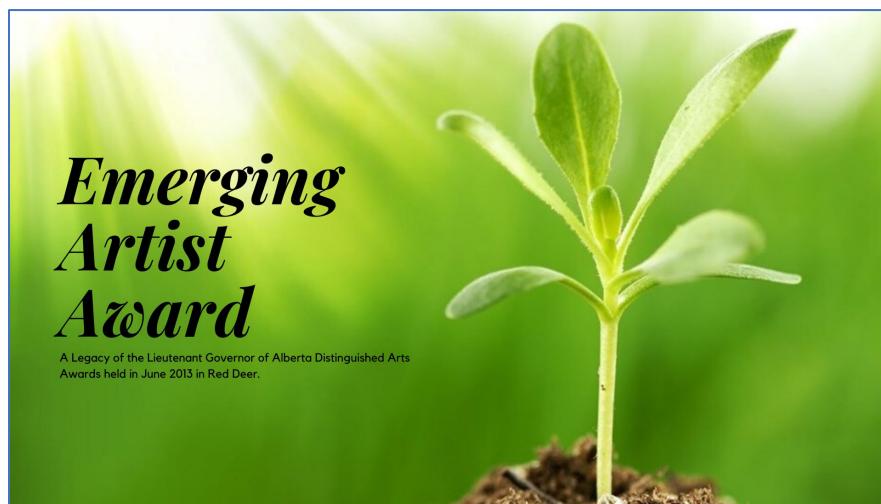

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

MY APPLICATION INCLUDES:

- This completed checklist to ensure you submit a complete application (page 2)
- Emerging Artist Award Application Form (page 3)

- A cover letter including responses to the questions noted on page 3.
- A detailed, up-to-date professional artistic résumé or Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Artist biography (max 500 words)
- Intended use of the funds
- Supporting documents for various genres:
 - **Literary:** Writing samples, not more than 20 pages single-sided, double-spaced
 - **Visual:** Up to 10 visual images with title, media, date produced. Submit clear images of your work – the images should be free of other subject matter and have appropriate lighting and colour quality or clear videos or legible literary works,
 - **Performing:** Audio or video files with a combined viewing time of no more than ten minutes or relevant material (see tips at the end of this document.)
 - Ensure that your submission is neat, labelled, easy to view and provides positive examples of your work,
 - Do not include original works of art or one-of-a-kind support materials. Red Deer Arts Council is not responsible for loss or damage of application materials submitted,
 - DVD, CD, USB, functioning direct web links* or a hard copy are acceptable formats for applications (files submitted electronically must be organized in a single folder),
 - Images should be in JPEG (.jpg, .jpeg) format in RGB colour mode and be the original large size format or in appropriate materials depending on your artistic endeavour (e.g., video for singer/songwriter, filmmaker, etc.)

**The Red Deer Arts Council is not responsible for non-functioning web links preventing access to review submission materials. Any web links must land directly on the required page and not require a login or other entry to be viewed/played. **

- Each page of my application & support materials is numbered and labelled with my name.
- All written materials are in black text, using a standard, easy-to-read font. No highlights or shaded areas, which make documents hard to read or photocopy.
- All pages are standard letter size 8 ½ x 11” paper.
- There are no staples, binders, or sleeves in the written portion of my application.

We recommend you DO NOT ask the jury to look up materials relevant to your application, if they are important, provide them with your application.

Support Materials for Submission

Literary Artists:

Include no more than 20 pages of original writing in English, double-spaced and single-sided. Submit creative forms such as poetry, fiction, creative non-fiction, and/or children’s literature presented in an easily readable font size. Submit as a hard copy or in a standard Word, Google Docs, or PDF digital format. We are unable to accept Apple ‘Pages’ files.

Visual Artists:

Include a USB key or cloud folder link* with 9 to 18 digital images of individual artwork, at least two-thirds of which were completed within the last year. Ensure that all file names are clearly identified/named and include a corresponding list using the below format indicating Title, Media, Date, and Size (W x H x D in inches/feet.)

Include an artist statement for at least ONE of the works in the portfolio. Do not send actual artworks, they will not be returned. You may copy and type directly into the below chart.

Performing and Cinematic Artists:

Submission may include a CD, DVD, website links (where your video is hosted), cloud folder links, or a USB key with 2 or 3 samples of the candidate’s choice in performance, one of which must be solo. Total duration of all content should not exceed 10 minutes. *Please see the Tips for Performing Artists on page 7 of this document.*

**The Red Deer Arts Council is not responsible for non-functional web links preventing access to review the submission materials. Any web links must land directly on the required page and not require a login or other entry to be viewed/played. Ensure the cloud link remains accessible without issue for at least 3 months upon submission. Materials that cannot be accessed will not be considered. Other means of delivery we suggest are: wetransfer.com or providing a thumb drive. **

Provide all materials relevant to your application. If they are important, DO NOT ask the jury to look them up, please include them. Additional supporting documents are a good thing.
